

Corteva Agriscience

Corteva Agriscience is an international agriculture R&D company that produces and supplies farmers around the world with advanced seeds and innovative crop protection products. The company is listed at the New York Stock Exchange and summarizes the experience of its predecessors DuPont and Dow, based on the values of ethical business conduct, human health, safety and care for the environment. Corteva works in 130 countries and adheres to the principles of sustainability, its purpose is to enrich the lives of those who produce and those who consume, ensuring progress for generations to come. The company is convinced that respect for human life is the highest value, and was one of the first to condemn the large-scale war started by Russia against Ukraine and to withdraw from the Russian market and, having already suspended new sales, initiated a plan to stop all production and commercial activities in Russia. As a sign of support for Ukrainians, Corteva is actively involved in helping victims and evacuees, taking care of life and food security, and providing funding for charitable and humanitarian projects in these areas:

- **Assistance to the elderly** - the company provided funding to the Let's Help Charitable Foundation for the purchase of 1,800 long-term food kits for poor single elderly people in need and those registered at local territorial social protection centers in Kyiv, Zhytomyr, Chernihiv, Cherkasy, Sumy, Poltava, Odesa, and Zaporizhia oblasts in areas close to hostilities or in newly liberated territories. With Corteva's support, lonely elderly people, who were left alone and in distress during the war, isolated and immobile, received a supply of monthly food sets about 30 kg each.
- **Assistance to people with disabilities** - the company provided funding to the Kharkiv public association "Through the War", which takes care of the needs of people in the Kharkiv region who can not take care of themselves. The assistance received from the company will cover the needs for food, medical and other services of 120 families during the month.
- **Assistance to the Mykolayiv City Ambulance Hospital** - the company financed the purchase of equipment that will ensure the smooth operation of the institution, close to the zone of active hostilities.
- **Assistance to victims in the liberated territories** - the company financed the activities of the inclusive bakery Good Bread, which after the liberation from the occupiers of villages in Kyiv and Chernihiv, organized the supply of bread. Employees of the company - people with mental disabilities (mental retardation, autism, Down syndrome, etc.) - with the funding of Corteva cooked about 7,000 loaves of bread, which were distributed to victims in the liberated areas.
- **"Victory Gardens"** - the company joined the All-Ukrainian initiative "Victory Gardens", aimed at the efficient use of local land available to local communities and directing available resources to grow food for families to prevent the food crisis in Ukraine. The initiative is being implemented by the Government Reform Support in Ukraine (SURGe) project with the support of the Government of Canada. As part of the initiative, communities receive assistance in increasing the number of vegetables grown, processing, storage, and marketing of the harvest, including by providing appropriate equipment (drying, autoclaves, etc.). Some of the equipment will be purchased with funding from Corteva Agriscience, which will help communities improve their food security and use the products grown not only for their own needs but also for those communities and people most in need.
- **Global Giving** - Corteva is matching employee donations dollar for dollar up and supports the GlobalGiving Ukraine Crisis Relief Fund, which provides humanitarian assistance to affected communities in Ukraine and surrounding areas where Ukrainian refugees have been evacuated, providing them with access to food, water, shelter, medical care, and more.
- **Global FoodBanking Network** – Corteva is matching employee donations dollar for dollar up and finances the Global FoodBanking Network program, which supports the food bank in Ukraine.
- **Supply of medicines from abroad** - Corteva has established financing and supply of necessary medicines for the needs of communities and hospitals in Kyiv, Poltava, and Kharkiv regions, organizing the purchase of goods abroad, including tourniquets, hemostatic materials, painkillers, antibiotics and more. Some of the materials were provided by the company's employees as a donation through the American non-profit organization Convoy of Hope.
- **Volunteer initiatives of employees** - Corteva employees constantly help victims on their own initiative. In particular, employees of the Stasi Nasinnia production facility in Poltava region removed and resettled many women, children, and the elderly from safety zones in Kharkiv, Sumy and Donetsk regions. Colleagues working in other countries collect money, humanitarian aid (medicines, food, equipment, generators) for the affected regions of Ukraine and accommodate refugees.
