

Does your organization continue to pay salaries after almost 10 months of war?








Other – 2%:

- full salary depending on the employees' workload






Have your organization's plants/factories/facilities/storehouses/offices been damaged during almost 10 months of war?

- ono facilities/plants/storehouses/offices in Ukraine






Have any of your organization's employees been injured or killed during almost 10 months of war?












Does your organization continue to provide humanitarian support after almost 10 months of war?




Other – 2%:

Other:


- reservation of staff

- inability to make payments to foreign reinsurers






Does your organization plan to continue operating in Ukraine in 2023?







When do you think Ukraine's post-war rebuilding and reconstruction will begin?




difficult to answer -4% after Ukraine's victory -2%





Do you think Russia should pay war reparations to Ukraine?






Other – 3%:
