

URGENCY OF SITUATION

- Shortage of trained EOD and medical personnel
- Enormous increase of landmines, IEDs, Booby-Traps, and Unexploded Ordnance
- Requirement for advanced training and technology to stay up with the threat
- Hospitals above a 500% utilization rate
- Shortage of surgical supplies
- Extraordinary demands on 'First Responders'





MISSION

Osprey Relief Foundation conducts a 'Train the Trainer' Course for Ukrainian 'First Responders' (EMT, EOD, Firefighter, Police, Border Gaurds) in Ukraine Sep 11-22, 2023.


CONCEPT

The Course will focus on Search, Rescue and lifesaving capabilities in support of civilians on the battlefied and wounded military personel. The Osprey Course is enhanced with 'state of the art' technology with the integration of drone, robot, radar, stand-alone communications and Canine.

DONOR RETURN ON INVESTMENT

- 60 First Responders Trained by Osprey Training experts from Tier One military, law enforcement and first responders backgrounds.
- Each Trainee is charged with training 10 other Ukrainian First Responders Providing a 10:1 multiple (60=600)





OVERSIGHT

- Osprey Relief Foundation is an American 501c3 non-profit organization with US Government oversight of its use of funds.
- Osprey will handle all operational funds and expenditures for this mission and WILL NOT turn over funds to the Ukrainian Government.

CREDENTIALS

2022: Osprey has conducted seven trips into Ukraine since March '22

- Evacuations of orphanages/ Senior Care Facilities along the front lines/ delivered essential goods where needed
- Established a Network throughout Romania, Poland, and Ukraine
- Osprey 'Train the Trainer' Pilot Program conducted Nov '22 resulted in request for additional training in 2023
- Testimonial letters from the Director of the National Academy of Internal Affairs, Minister of Internal Affairs, and the Director of Education were sent to the US ambassador highlighting the excellence of training.


